FBI, Albuquerque Police Seek 'Shop and Rob Bandit' After Bank Robbery

Bank robbery on Friday, May 20, 2022

Albuquerque, New Mexico, 23.05.2022, 19:15 Time

USPA NEWS - The FBI and Albuquerque Police Department are seeking the public's assistance to identify the "Shop and Rob Bandit," who is responsible for a bank robbery on Friday, May 20, 2022.

At approximately 11:13 a.m., an unknown male entered First Convenience Bank, located inside the Walmart Supercenter at 2266 Wyoming Boulevard NE. The suspect handed a demand note to a teller. The robber received an undisclosed sum of money and left the bank heading north on foot.

Suspect's Description:

Sex: Male

Race: Black

Height: 6'0"

Build: Thin

Clothing: Dark blue flat cap, eyeglasses, dark mask over his mouth, purple and white checkered long-sleeve shirt, dark pants, brown shoes.

Other: The suspect wore a green pack slung over his chest.

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$2,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of this suspect.

Bank robbery carries a possible prison term of up to 20 years. The use of a gun, other dangerous weapon, toy gun, or hoax bomb device during the commission of a bank robbery can be punishable by a prison term of up to 25 years.
